Viola doesn't know how to put her off and hints that she is a girl, not the boy she is pretending to be.</p>	<p>Malvolio obeys the letter and wearing yellow stockings, smiles and tells Olivia how he loves her. The normally serious Steward looks ridiculous.</p>	<p>Olivia is sure Malvolio must be mad and orders Sir Toby to look after him. But Toby takes the joke further and has him thrown in a dungeon cell.</p>	<p>For a joke, Sir Toby gets Sir Andrew and Viola into a duel, telling each how fierce the other is. Just as they begin to fight, Sebastian's friend Antonio leaps in to stop the fight, he doesn't know it is Viola.</p>
<p>Viola's brother Sebastian is suddenly attacked by Sir Andrew, who thinks he is Viola. Olivia rushes out to stop the fight. Sebastian thinks she is wonderful and is amazed that she treats him like an old friend.</p>	<p>Olivia persuades Sebastian – whom she assumes is the disguised Viola – to marry her. But later when she calls the real Viola her husband, Viola denies it. Olivia is confused and Orsino feels betrayed.</p>	<p>As soon as the twins are in the same place at the same time and people see them together, they understand what has been going on. Orsino is pleased and asks Viola to marry him. Olivia calls Viola her sister 😊</p>	<p>Just as the happy couple are about to get married, Malvolio arrives and swears to get revenge for the cruel trick played on him.
