<p>Introduction The brief leading paragraph – Most important information</p> <p><i>Who, What, When, Where and Why</i></p>	<p>Who What When</p>
<p>Body Summary of the story with the main details using short, simple sentences and short paragraphs, beginning with the most interesting and important parts of the story. Provides additional information.</p> <p>Why did it happen. How did it happen.</p> <p>Include quotes from eyewitnesses.</p>	
<p>The Tail Conclusion. Tying up loose ends. What will happen as a result of this event?</p>
